

**SHENANDOAH VALLEY ELECTRIC COOPERATIVE
MT. CRAWFORD, VIRGINIA**

**SCHEDULE PPQ
LARGE PRIMARY**

AVAILABILITY

Available to Consumers with monthly capacity requirements of 5,000 kilowatts or more that can be served from 138,000/34,500 volt Load Center Substation located within 5 miles of the point of delivery to the Consumer. Also available at 12,470 volts where the Cooperative elects, at its sole option, to supply Service direct from an adjacent 138,000 volt transmission line by a single transformation. Also available to Consumers with monthly capacity requirements of 10,000 kilowatts and over, located adjacent to 138,000 volt transmission lines. Service shall not be available for Standby or Maintenance Service. Service will be delivered and metered at 34,500 volts or over. An Electric Service Agreement shall be executed.

Available to all Member/Consumers of this class within the new service territory acquired from Potomac Edison Company.

MONTHLY RATE

A. Distribution Charge

1. Basic Consumer Charge \$124.95 per billing month
2. Variable Distribution Charge
 - (a) Capacity Charge:
All kw as set forth below under "Determination of Capacity"
@\$0.21 per kw
 - (b) Energy Charge:
All kwhs @\$0.00067 per kwhs
3. RKVA Charge:
Rkva charge is applied to the Consumer's rkva capacity requirement in excess of 25% of the consumer's kw capacity.
 - (a) Rkva \$0.40 per rkva

B. Power Supply Charge

1. Power Supply Charge
 - (a) Demand Charge:
All kw as set forth below under "Determination of Capacity"
@\$7.13 per kw
 - (b) Energy Charge:
All kwhs @\$0.02174 per kwhs

The above charges are subject to the Levelized Purchased Power Factor, Schedule LPPFQ, or the Cooperative's Wholesale Power Cost Adjustment Clause, Schedule WPA-1Q

MINIMUM CHARGE

Rate Schedule Billing

DETERMINATION OF CAPACITY

KILOWATT CAPACITY

Kilowatt billing capacity (billing demand) during a billing period shall be the highest of:

1. The maximum 30 minute metered kilowatt capacity, or
2. For Consumers contracting for "off-peak" Service the billing capacity for any month shall be the maximum capacity measured during "on-peak" hours plus 25 percent of the amount that the maximum capacity measured during "off-peak" hours exceeds the maximum "on-peak" capacity subject to provisions set forth below.
"Off-Peak" hours shall be from 10:00 pm to 7:00 am daily plus all hours of Sunday.
3. 60% of the maximum instantaneous kilowatt capacity.

However, the "Billing Capacity" for any month shall not be less than the highest of:

- (a) 5,000 kilowatts, or
- (b) 75% of the kilowatt capacity specified in the Electric Service Agreement, or
- (c) 75% of the highest "Billing Capacity" established during the preceding eleven months.

REACTIVE KILOVOLTAMPERE CAPACITY

Reactive kilovolt-ampere capacity is the highest metered demand in reactive kilovolt-amperes established over a 30-minute interval during a billing period.

Kilowatts and reactive kilovolt-amperes will be computed to the nearest whole number

ELECTRIC SERVICE AGREEMENT AND TERM

An Electric Service Agreement is required for a minimum term of five years for Distribution Charges. A new agreement may be required where the Consumer increases capacity requirement.

GENERAL

The Cooperative may, at its option, extend Service to the "Point Of Service" of a Consumer's plant located beyond five miles from a Load Center Substation, provided, the Consumer will pay an additional charge for transmission line facilities in excess of five miles. Distances will be computed in pole miles to the nearest tenth of a mile.

CONSUMPTION TAX

Applies to all kilowatt-hours served under this Rate Schedule

LATE PAYMENT CHARGE

Applies to this Rate Schedule
