PRIVATE OUTDOOR AREA LIGHTING SERVICE**

AVAILABILITY

Service under this Rate Schedule is available only for installations served on this Rate Schedule prior to December 13; 1985. The rating of lamps in lumens is for identification and shall approximate the manufacturer's standard rating.

Available to all Member/Consumers of this class within the new service territory acquired from Potomac Edison Company

TERM OF CONTRACT

Service is sold under contract to take continuous Service under this Rate Schedule for a minimum period of five years for Distribution Charges.

In the event of early termination, the Consumer shall pay either the balance of the contract responsibility or the net cost of installation and removal of the facilities installed by the Cooperative to serve the Consumer, whichever is less.

GENERAL

Service supplied is subject to the Rules and Regulations Covering the Supply of Electric Service of the Cooperative as filed with the Commission.

All lamps are lighted from dusk to dawn every night, or for approximately 4,200 hours per annum.

The Consumer shall obtain written approval from public authorities for lights to be located on public thoroughfares.

The Consumer shall select the location of all poles installed on the Consumer's property under the provisions of this Rate Schedule and poles will be relocated only on payment by the Consumer of the cost of such relocation. The Consumer shall be responsible for all damages to, or loss of, the Cooperative's property located on the Consumer's premises unless resulting from causes beyond the Consumer's control.

When the Consumer requires the Cooperative to furnish facilities in excess of those normally supplied by the Cooperative, the Consumer shall pay the Cooperative's investment, with the maintenance of the special equipment subject to (1) time and ability to obtain replacement, and (2) advance payment of the then excess cost over standard for each replacement.

When lighting is served from an overhead circuit the Consumer may elect to own and maintain the poles and circuits upon which the Cooperative will install the lighting fixture. Consumer owned facilities shall be approved by the Cooperative.

When lighting is served from an underground circuit the Consumer shall own, install and maintain all necessary concrete bases for poles to be installed in accordance with Cooperative's specifications. The Consumer shall also own, install and maintain all facilities including circuits, conduit and pedestals necessary to supply service to the base of the pole.

CUSTOMER OWNED EQUIPMENT-COOPERATIVE OPERATES AND MAINTAINS

Whenever the Consumer furnishes, installs and owns the entire lighting system using equipment approved by and installed in a manner acceptable to the Cooperative, the Cooperative may at its discretion, operate and maintain the system at the following monthly rates.

The above charges are subject to the Levelized Purchased Power Factor, Schedule LPPFQ, or the Cooperative's Wholesale Power Cost Adjustment Clause, Schedule WPA-1Q.

The Cooperative's responsibility under the aforementioned charges for maintaining the Consumer owned lighting system is limited to photo control, relamping, cleaning fixtures and painting poles requiring paint. When the Consumer's equipment is intermediate in size to those listed above the Consumer shall pay the monthly charges applicable to the next larger size.
