**SCHEDULE SLQ
STREET AND HIGHWAY LIGHTING SERVICE**

AVAILABILITY

Available only for incandescent lighting installations served on or before December 1, 1972 for lighting of public streets, public highways and other public outdoor areas where Service is supplied from the existing Distribution System and where the Cooperative owns and maintains all equipment. Service will be supplied from dusk to dawn each night. The rating of lamps in lumens is for identification and shall approximate the manufacturer's standard rating Existing fixtures will not be replaced at the end of their useful life is replacements cannot be secured through normal supply channels. The Cooperative will be the sole judge as to the end of the useful life.

Available to all Member/Consumers of this class within the new service territory acquired from Potomac Edison Cooperative

TERM OF CONTRACT

One year for Distribution Charges, renewable annually.

GENERAL

Special equipment required for lighting bridges and subways shall be maintained by the Consumer, except lamp bulbs, which shall be furnished and renewed by the Cooperative. No work shall be done on Consumer's equipment connected to the Cooperative's Distribution System without the Cooperative's approval.
