**SCHEDULE A-10 (UNBUNDLED)  
RESIDENTIAL SERVICE**

AVAILABILITY

Available to member/customers for normal uses in full-time, permanent, single-family residences and residential farms, where such residential structure is occupied on a full-time basis as the principal place of residence for at least nine (9) months per year. All subject to the established rules and regulations of the Cooperative.

TYPE OF SERVICE

Single-phase, 60-cycles at available voltage.

MONTHLY RATE

- A. Distribution Charge
1. Basic Consumer Charge: \$ 13.76 per billing month
  2. Variable Distribution Charge:  
    First           300 kWh @ 2.192 cents per kWh  
    Excess over 300 kWh @ 2.076 cents per kWh
- B. Power Supply Charge
1. All kWhs @ 4.377 cents per kWh
  2. The above charges are subject to the adjustment for changes in Wholesale Power Costs as per the Cooperative's Wholesale Power Cost Adjustment Clause, Schedule WPA.
  3. The above charges (1. And 2.) do not apply to consumers obtaining generation from an alternate energy supplier and the CTC charge only applies if an alternate energy supplier is chosen.

SPECIAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- A. The capacity of individual motors under this schedule shall not exceed ten horsepower (10 hp).
- B. Meter readings may be billed in units of 10 kWh.
- C. Meters to be read by member/customers except special cases where read by the Cooperative, or where automatic remote meter reading (AMR) is installed.

In addition to the above, the general Terms and Conditions for Supplying Electric Distribution Service of the Cooperative, as filed with the Virginia State Corporation Commission, shall apply.
