**SCHEDULE SSD-2 (UNBUNDLED)
SURGE SUPPRESSION DEVICE**

AVAILABILITY

Available to all residential member/customers where power being provided is single phase, 60 cycles, at the Cooperative's standard voltage to a meter base rated at 200 amperes or less with adequate grounding.

SERVICE AGREEMENT

- A. Upon application, the Cooperative will install and maintain a surge suppression device(s) on the premises of the member/customer. The member/customer must agree to keep the device for at least 12 months. Failure to complete the initial 12-month agreement will result in the remainder of the agreement being billed as a one-time fee to the member/customer.
- B. The member/customer shall notify the Cooperative when the device fails to operate. The device will be serviced within 72 hours of such notification under normal conditions.
- C. The member/customer will be billed for the surge suppression device each billing period and such charges added to the regular electric bill at a rate of \$4.95 per installed meter-collar.
- D. A one-time contribution-in-aid of \$30.00 per device will be required prior to installation.

The facilities will remain the property of, and will be maintained and replaced as becomes necessary by the Cooperative.

OPTION – POINT OF USE

The Cooperative offers optional point-of-use surge protection devices for installation by the member/customer. The optional surge suppression/UPS point-of-use devices will be offered at a market price. These point-of-use devices may be purchased at any of the offices of the Cooperative.
